NEL and Scotiabank enjoy gains

TRADING in eight securities produced a total volume of 41,317 shares being traded with a value of \$1.62 million. Republic Bank Ltd was the volume leader as 20,281 shares changed hands valued at \$1.38 million.

Sagicor Financial Corporation, National Enterprises Ltd and Scotiabank Trinidad & Tobago Ltd added volumes of 10,250, 3,893 and 2,593 shares respectively with corre-

sponding values of \$87,110.82, \$38,930.00 and \$94,698.49. Other noteworthy performers included FirstCaribbean International Bank Ltd and Scotia DBG Investments Ltd which posted volumes of 2,000 and 1,500 shares and respective values of \$16,520 and \$1,950.

Advances monopolised the session as National Enterprises Ltd gained \$0.50 to close at \$10 and Scotiabank Trinidad & Tobago

Ltd climbed \$0.28 to \$36.50.

The Mutual Fund Market was inactive. Prices stood firm at \$5.11 for Caribbean Property Fund, \$3.40 for Praetorian Property Mutual Fund and \$62.51 for Savinvest India Asia Fund.

The Second Tier Market was inactive. Prices were unchanged at \$1 for FNCU-Venture Capital Company Ltd and \$13.50 for Mora Ven Holdings Ltd.

January 9 is new census date

FOR THE second time this year, the decennial (ten year) Trinidad and Tobago population and housing census was launched. The first census, which was expected to begin May 16 was postponed because of the snap decision by former Prime Minister Patrick Manning to conduct General Elections on May 24.

Planning, Economic and Social Restructuring and Gender Affairs Minister, Senator Mary King said the census is crucial in the country's development planning process. "Government recognises the need for evidence based planning at the forefront of our developmental paradigm and see statistics as an essential element to improve our ability to develop appropriate policies," she said.

The launch took place yesterday and was celebrated as the first World Statistics Day, at the Trinidad Hyatt Regency hotel, Port-of-Spain. King explained if Government does not have the data, they will not know where to go to look after the poor, the sick and the disabled. The census, she said, will also give Government

an idea of how far the country has progressed in fulfilling the United Nations Millennium Development Goals. King noted the length of time it takes to report the results on the census but she noted as the nation progresses in Information and Communications Technology, analysis will be done faster.

January 9, 2011 is the new census night according Director of Statistics, Dave Clement, who is also the Census Officer for the mass population and housing count. He explained that midnight on this day will be the point of reference for the census so when the actual tally takes place, persons will have to reference what they were doing at midnight on that day.

Clement said the CSO's commitment to deliver preliminary results within the 12-month period following the census is ambitious considering prior census reporting but it is a target they are determined to meet. "The use of scanning technology will contribute to faster data processing and earlier release of the preliminary results of the 2010 census," he said.
