ACS Secretary-General Meets with Serbia's State Secretary to Discuss Cooperation and Upcoming Summit

- Invitation to Belgrade Expo 2027: The State Secretary extended an invitation to the ACS to participate in the exposition that Serbia will host in Belgrade in 2027.
