1.4 Justification	In the current context of expanding tourism and for effective participation in global economies, the diversity of languages is one of the obstacles that affect regional co-operation among all ACS member countries. Language diversity is a barrier towards effective negotiations that can be further complicated, for instance, by unsatisfactory translations. Having more multilingual professionals in the Greater Caribbean region would therefore harness better working relations between the ACS Members.	
1.5 Outputs / Components	The project proposed by the ACS is an Intensive Language Training and Immersion Programme (in French, Spanish and English) for key personnel dealing with regional cooperation matters in all Member States (Government officials, businessmen and foreign language teachers) that will take place in language training institutions located in ACS Member and Associate Member countries.	
	In addition to the common <i>language courses</i> , each category of candidates will receive a <i>specific training module</i> directly linked to their professional area. For example, foreign language teachers will be introduced to foreign language teaching methodologies, businessmen and government officials will be taught specific vocabulary of their professional area. The programme will also include <i>internships</i> at specific institutions linked to the professional areas of each professional category of candidates after the successful completion of the immersion module.
